

1 in 15 Americans will be diagnosed with lung cancer. More than 221,000 will be diagnosed this year


60%-65%

of all new lung cancer diagnoses are among people who have never smoked or are former smokers



10%-15%

Lung cancer can affect anyone regardless of gender or ethnicity




433 Americans will die of lung cancer today

FACT: LUNG CANCER IS RARELY DETECTED EARLY ON


Lung cancer accounts for **13%** of all new cancer diagnoses, but **27%** of cancer deaths

Only **17%** of all people diagnosed with lung cancer will **survive 5 years** or more, but if it is caught before it spreads, the chance for 5-year survival improves dramatically



Lung cancer takes more lives annually in the U.S. than the next three deadliest cancers combined




Lung cancer kills three times as many men as **prostate cancer**

Lung cancer is the leading cause of cancer death, taking almost **160,000 lives** each year, yet **only 6% of federal research dollars** spent on cancer research are spent on lung cancer
